If the submission is accepted, it will not be possible to present the paper online.

Who can apply:

- AISG Members in good standing with the payment of the annual membership fee up to and including 2025.
- Non-member, if their proposal is accepted, will have to pay 50 euros to attend the conference.
- Travel and accommodation expenses for speakers are not covered.
- Papers accepted at the 2025 conference will only be published in “Materia Giudaica”, if approved by a positive double Peer Review.
- Panels of three-four papers max are encouraged.

The deadline for submitting proposals is 31 March 2025.

The Scientific Committee will communicate the outcome of the evaluation by 30 April 2025.

Lectures in Italian, English, French and Spanish are accepted.

- Each presenter will have 25 minutes for their presentation + 10 minutes for discussion.
